Achieving the Best Performance

- Use only good quality connection cables (we recommend Kramer high-performance, high-resolution cables) to avoid interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables).
- Do not secure the cables in tight bundles or roll the slack into tight coils.
- Avoid interference from neighbouring electrical appliances that may adversely influence signal quality.
- Position your Kramer **RTBUS-24** away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust.



This equipment is to be used only inside a building. It may only be connected to other equipment that is installed inside a building.

Caution: There are no operator serviceable parts inside the unit.

Warning: Use only the power cord that is supplied with the unit.

Warning: Do not open the unit. High voltages can cause electrical shock! Servicing by qualified personnel only.

Overview

Congratulations on purchasing your Kramer **RTBUS-24 Round Table Connection Bus**. The **RTBUS-24** is an elegant furniture-mounted, round connection bus. The **RTBUS-24** features a pneumatic mechanism for pneumatic lifting and smooth closing of its lid. It is easily installed into a table or podium top, and its interface enables you to connect any equipment to systems installed in a room via the following connectors:

- Two 125V US power sockets (5A when connecting a single power socket and a total of 6A when connecting both sockets).
- Two 2A USB ports for charging devices.
- One HDMI connector (supporting HDMI with Deep Color, x.v.Color™, Lip Sync, HDMI Uncompressed Audio Channels, Dolby TrueHD, DTS-HD, and CEC).
- One C14 power socket and one HDMI connector on the underside of the unit.

RTBUS-24 comes with a black or silver sandblast textured lid.

Typical Applications

The **RTBUS-24** is ideal for:

- Boardrooms.
- Conference rooms.
- Training rooms.
- Hotel lobbies.
- Cafes and restaurants.

Defining the RTBUS-24 Round Table Connection Bus

This section defines the RTBUS-24.




Figure 1: RTBUS-24 Round Table Connection Bus

#	Feature	Function
①	Pop-up Lid	Covers the connecting surface, leaving the table surface neat and tidy.
②	Outer Rim	Fits over a table surface.
③	Pneumatic Mechanism	Enables automatic lifting and smooth closing of the lid.




Figure 2: RTBUS-24 Connecting Surface

④	Connecting Surface	See Figure 2 .
⑤	Rubber Protectors (x2)	Protect the table surface when mounting the unit.
⑥	Locking Butterfly Nuts (x2)	Tighten to lock the mounting butterfly screw.
⑦	Mounting Screws (x2)	For securing the RTBUS-24 to the table.
⑧	Mounting Butterfly Nuts (x2)	Tighten to secure the unit to the table surface.

#	Feature	Function
9	Mounting Brackets (x2)	Place in the bracket slits after inserting the enclosure into the table, for securing the unit to the table surface
10	Mounting Bracket Slits (two slits on each side)	Insert the mounting brackets to the slits when installing the RTBUS-24 (see Mounting the RTBUS-24 in a Table on page 5).
11	HDMI Cable	Connect to an HDMI acceptor.

#	Feature	Function
12	5A/125V Power Connector (x2)	Connect to up to two US power consuming devices simultaneously.  When a single power socket is connected, consumption should not exceed 5A. When both power sockets are connected, the total consumption should not exceed 6A.
13	5V-2A USB CHARGING Port (x2)	Use to charge up to two devices simultaneously.
14	Lid Latch	For safely closing the lid.
15	HDMI Connector	Connect to an HDMI source.

Drilling a Hole in the Table

To drill an opening in a table:

1. Using any standard cup bit drill with a diameter ranging from 111mm to 114mm (4.37" to 4.49"), drill a hole in the table in the desired location.



The thickness of the table should be 76mm (3") or less.

2. Clean the table surface.




Take care not to damage the table. Kramer Electronics is not responsible for any damage caused to the table.


Mounting the RTBUS-24 in a Table

To mount the unit, follow these steps:

Step 1: Insert the RTBUS-24 into the hole cut into the table, making sure the outer rim is firm against the surface of the table.




Step 2: From underneath the table, slide the mounting brackets into the appropriate slots.



Step 3: Tighten the butterfly mounting screws securely upward against the table.

Step 4: Lock the mounting screws into position with the locking butterfly screws.



Connecting the Cables and Wires

Following installation connect the cables to the underside of the unit:

- Connect the HDMI connector to an HDMI acceptor.
- Connect the power cable to a power source.



Make sure that when:

- A single power socket is connected, consumption should not exceed 5A.
- Both power sockets are connected, the total consumption should not exceed 6A.

Using the RTBUS-24

Once the RTBUS-24 is installed, you can easily customize it to your own needs by directly plugging in the required AV equipment.




Figure 3: Connecting RTBUS-24

This limited warranty covers defects in materials and workmanship in this product.

What is Not Covered

This limited warranty does not cover any damage, deterioration or malfunction resulting from any alteration, modification, improper or unreasonable use or maintenance, misuse, abuse, accident, neglect, exposure to excess moisture, fire, improper packing and shipping (such claims must be presented to the carrier), lightning, power surges, or other acts of nature. This limited warranty does not cover any damage, deterioration or malfunction resulting from the installation or removal of this product from any installation, any unauthorized tampering with this product, any repairs attempted by anyone unauthorized by Kramer Electronics to make such repairs, or any other cause which does not relate directly to a defect in materials and/or workmanship of this product. This limited warranty does not cover cartons, equipment enclosures, cables or accessories used in conjunction with this product.

Without limiting any other exclusion herein, Kramer Electronics does not warrant that the product covered hereby, including, without limitation, the technology and/or integrated circuit(s) included in the product, will not become obsolete or that such items are or will remain compatible with any other product or technology with which the product may be used.

How Long this Coverage Lasts

The standard limited warranty for Kramer products is seven (7) years from the date of original purchase, with the following exceptions:

1. All Kramer VIA products are covered by a standard three (3) year warranty for VIA hardware and a standard one (1) year warranty for firmware and software updates. (An extended software warranty plan for an additional 2 years can be purchased separately).
2. All Kramer fiber optic cables and adapters, active cables, all Kramer speakers and Kramer touch panels are covered by a standard one (1) year warranty.
3. All Kramer Cobra products, all Kramer Calibre products, all Kramer Minicom digital signage products, all HighSecLabs products, all streaming, and all wireless products are covered by a standard three (3) year warranty.
4. All Sierra Video MultiViewers are covered by a standard five (5) year warranty.
5. Sierra switchers & control panels are covered by a standard seven (7) year warranty (excluding power supplies and fans that are covered for three (3) years).
6. K-Touch software is covered by a standard one (1) year warranty for software updates.
7. All Kramer passive cables are covered by a ten (10) year warranty.

Who is Covered

Only the original purchaser of this product is covered under this limited warranty. This limited warranty is not transferable to subsequent purchasers or owners of this product.

What Kramer Electronics Will Do

Kramer Electronics will, at its sole option, provide one of the following three remedies to whatever extent it shall deem necessary to satisfy a proper claim under this limited warranty:

1. Elect to repair or facilitate the repair of any defective parts within a reasonable period of time, free of any charge for the necessary parts and labor to complete the repair and restore this product to its proper operating condition. Kramer Electronics will also pay the shipping costs necessary to return this product once the repair is complete.
2. Replace this product with a direct replacement or with a similar product deemed by Kramer Electronics to perform substantially the same function as the original product.
3. Issue a refund of the original purchase price less depreciation to be determined based on the age of the product at the time remedy is sought under this limited warranty.

What Kramer Electronics Will Not Do Under This Limited Warranty

If this product is returned to Kramer Electronics or the authorized dealer from which it was purchased or any other party authorized to repair Kramer Electronics products, this product must be insured during shipment, with the insurance and shipping charges prepaid by you. If this product is returned uninsured, you assume all risks of loss or damage during shipment. Kramer Electronics will not be responsible for any costs related to the removal or re-installation of this product from or into any installation. Kramer Electronics will not be responsible for any costs related to any setting up this product, any adjustment of user controls or any programming required for a specific installation of this product.

How to Obtain a Remedy Under This Limited Warranty

To obtain a remedy under this limited warranty, you must contact either the authorized Kramer Electronics reseller from whom you purchased this product or the Kramer Electronics office nearest you. In order to pursue any remedy under this limited warranty, you must possess an original, dated receipt as proof of purchase from an authorized Kramer Electronics reseller. If this product is returned under this limited warranty, a return authorization number, obtained from Kramer Electronics, will be required (RMA number). You may also be directed to an authorized reseller or a person authorized by Kramer Electronics to repair the product.

If it is decided that this product should be returned directly to Kramer Electronics, this product should be properly packed, preferably in the original carton, for shipping. Cartons not bearing a return authorization number will be refused.
