Added Features:

- Add MIC setting and power button on Web page
- Add TALKOVER, Serial Number to P3000 commands
- Add Panel lock function in OSD Menu and Web page
- Add Standby ON/OFF feature by protocol commands (~01@STANDBY P1 -Off(0)/On(1)) and by pressing the power button on the Web page
- In Standby mode (sleep mode), the device sends a "device in sleep mode" message via communication channels when a button is pressed on the front panel and also when a command is sent to the device via communication channels
- Protocol commands were added for talkover parameters
- Talkover functionality was added in the Web page

Fixes:

- Automatic audio setting functionality was fixed. When the HDMI signal is lost, audio is taken from the analog audio input
- Solved GUI issues; the volume scale went out of frame
- Some parameters were not saved in the "Save/Load configuration file" feature
- While muted, pressing the volume level buttons didn't cancel the mute
- There was a unclear message after uploading a configuration file
- Audio from MIC2 was lower while MIC SELECT was configured to BOTH state
